**General remarks**

„**Loading**” or „**unloading**” means moving the cargo from ship’s side to ship’s hold or vice versa.

„**Direct reloading**” means moving cargo from land or river means of transport to ship’s side or vice versa.

“**Indirect reloading**” means moving cargo from land or river means of transport to a port warehouse or storage yard and later from warehouse to ship’s side or vice versa.

All rates in **EUR**.

All rates are for reloading a metric ton of cargo unless otherwise indicated

The storage terms are not valid for Duty Free area unless otherwise indicated. There is no free storage term for Duty Free Area

Note: for high-dimension loads (when 1 cbm weighs less than 200 kg - calculated as per whole B/L lot) DB Port Szczecin will charge additional 40% of the above mentioned rates (except windmill blades).

**3.1 Storage for high-dimension loads:**

- free storage term 7 days on yard
- from 8<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> day: 13,00 EUR per ton/day,
- from 15<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> day: 50,00 EUR per ton/day,
- from 31<sup>th</sup> to 60<sup>th</sup> day: 100,00 EUR per ton/day,
- from 61<sup>st</sup> day: 180,00 EUR per ton/day.

**3.2 Storage for non high-dimension loads:**

- free storage term 10 days on yard
- from 10<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> day: 6,50 EUR per ton/day,
- from 15<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> day: 19,00 EUR per ton/day,
- from 31<sup>th</sup> to 60<sup>th</sup> day: 38,00 EUR per ton/day,
- from 61<sup>st</sup> day: 75,00 EUR per ton/day.

  - from 31<sup>st</sup> day 1,30 EUR per ton/day

  - from 15<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> day yard 0,17 EUR per ton/day
  - from 31<sup>st</sup> day yard 0,35 EUR per ton/day

- 9.1 The rates include the service of equipment operator.
- 9.2 The time of hire is the period between leaving the base and returning there.
- 9.3 The charge is counted for every 30 minut period commenced.

## 10. Mooring charges

Rates for mooring or unmooring of vessels and the occupation of the quay by barges.

- 10.1 The mooring service is charged according to length of the vessel. To calculate the fee, the total length of a vessel (*loa – length overall*) rounded up to 1 cm (if necessary) is taken. In case of disputes, data of Lloyd’s Shipping Register are decisive.
- 10.2 In the case when a mooring worker needs to wait more than one hour due to lateness of the ship, an additional charge of 25% of the rate will be charged for each commenced hour.
- 10.3 For cancellation of an ordered mooring service the same rate applies as in 11.2



## **11. Attendance and berthage charges**

11.1 For attending to a vessel berthing at a reloading quay after loading/discharging is completed, and upon the lapse of free-of-charge period, DB Port Szczecin charges **0,65 EUR** per running metre of vessel and each commenced hour of attendance.

11.2 Berthage charges are calculated and levied by the Szczecin & Świnoujście Seaports Authority, based on a valid Port Tariff of the Szczecin & Świnoujście Seaports Authority.

11.3 In the case of towing a vessel to a different berthing place, the vessel bears the additional costs of towage, pilotage and mooring. Towing of a vessel is performed based on the decision of the DB Port Szczecin Dispatcher in the situation when there is a need to provide a space at a quay for another vessel.

## **12. Other rates and service conditions**

12.1 For technically accepted and forwarded wagon from/to rail operator a fare of **10,50 EUR** /wagon is charged.

12.2 Fare for man-hour work of a stevedore for ordered activities amounts to **37,50 EUR**.

12.3 Hourly fare has its use:

- in case of performing any ordered works, which are not included in rates,
- in case of break in loading, unloading, reloading, handling activities.

12.4 For other cargoes, relations and services not mentioned in this rate, service conditions will be agreed separately.
